Assignment Title: **Obstacle Limitation Study Kaufana Airport, Eua**

The Government of Tonga has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Tonga Climate Resilient Transport Project (TCRTP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for Obstacle Limitation Study Kaufana Airport, Eua.

The consulting services (“the Services”) includes (a) Survey of the runway dimensions, runway slope, threshold locations and heights, displaced thresholds, ARP, apron and taxiway locations and dimensions and aircraft stand position (WGS84 position); (b) Survey of features such as trees, buildings, poles, etc. that are significant obstacles in the RWY 16 & 34 approach, departure and transition areas based on the ICAO Annex 14 specifications and the Civil Aviation Regulation (Restriction of Use of Land) 1996 and NZCAR Part 139; and (c) Provide on-site training/attachment during the study on how the operator and regulator can continuously and regularly monitor the obstacle infringements in order to spot any changes and maintain clearance or enforce the requirements of the Civil Aviation Act 2014 and the ICAO Annex 14.

It is anticipated that the consultant will commence as soon as possible for a total of 5 weeks. The Consultant is expected to under this role from the home office and in-country. The detailed **Terms of Reference (TOR)** for the assignment can be obtained at the address given below.

The Ministry of Infrastructure, the Implementing Agency for TCRTP now invites eligible individuals (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services (attach curriculum vitae with description of experience in similar assignments, similar conditions, etc.). Firms’ staff may express interest through the employing firm for the assignment and, under such situation, only the experience and qualifications of individuals shall be considered in the selection process. The criteria for selecting the Consultant are:

- a. Holds at least 1st degree in surveying or its equivalence with post-graduate qualification in an aviation-related discipline
- b. At least 10 years of experience as an individual undertaking aerodrome or aeronautical survey
- c. Has knowledge of and worked within the pacific region, small island countries or developing countries
- d. Has conducted at least 5 similar works for aviation projects specifically on OLS survey
- e. Is knowledgeable of the ICAO Annexes 4 & 14 SARPs as well as the World Geodetic System – 1984 (WGS-84) Manual

The attention of interested Consultants (including firms) is drawn to paragraph 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank’s Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers dated July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018.
