1. The Government of Tonga has secured financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Tonga Climate Resilient Transport Project (TCRTP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under contract for Safety Improvement Works in Ohonua Eua Nafanua Port Lot No. 1 and Niuas Ports (Pasivulangi Port Niuatoputapu and Futu port Niuafou).
2. The **Ministry of Infrastructure (MOI)** now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the works:
 - a. **Lot 1 Ohonua Eua Nafanua Port** consisting of: (a) supplying and installing bollards, fenders, cathodic protection anodes and ladder; (b) constructing new capping beam to the whole sheet pile wall; (c) Repairing the ramp and (d) Refurbishing the toilet block which includes installing doors, windows as well as new roof. The delivery/construction period is **213 calendar days**.
 - b. **Lot 2 Niuatoputapu Pasivulangi Port and Niuafou Futu Port Niuas** consisting of: (a) filling void at eastern side of the wharf; (b) replacing existing bollards with reinforced concrete bollards; (c) repairing the existing pavement on causeway and wharf; (d) supplying and installing two new light poles on the wharf and the causeway; (e) supplying and installing one new truck tyre fender; (f) installing maritime aids to navigation at harbour (Buoys equipped with lights, batteries and solar panel and reinforced concrete anchors); and constructing a new passenger building. The delivery/construction period is **244 calendar days**.
3. **Bidders are allowed to bid for any one or both lots. Bids will be evaluated lot-wise, taking into account discounts offered, if any. The contracts for each lot will be awarded to the Bidder or Bidders offering the lowest evaluated cost to the Employer for both lots, subject to the selected Bidder(s) meeting the required qualification criteria for each lot or both lots as the case may be.**
4. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the **World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-Procurement in Investment Projects Financing" July 2016 and Revised November 2017**



and August 2018 (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below immediately after the deadline of submission.
